2016 National Test results:

Early Years — 69% of children made a 'good level of development', this is in line with the National Average

Key stage 1- 100% of pupils met the expected standard in Reading, and Writing and 92% in Maths. The National average for Reading, Writing and Maths combined was 60%.

Key stage 2- 100% met the expected standard in Reading and 100% in Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar. 86% in Maths. The National Average for Reading, Writing and Maths combined was 53%.
