### Early Years

### Year 1 Phonic scores

Year One were just below National Average at **66.7%**

By the end of Year 2 **100%** of pupils achieved the expected standard

### Key Stage One

14 children

Reading - **100%** of children reached the expected standard

Writing – **100%** of children reached the expected standard with **28.6%** were working at greater depth.

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling – **100%** of children reached the expected standard with **14.3%** were working at greater depth.

Maths – **85.7%** of children reached the expected standard

### Key Stage Two

7 children

#### Reading, writing and maths – Attainment

Reading, writing and maths combined **77%** reached expected standard, the National Average was 53%

Reading – **100%** reached expected standard (National Average was 66%) and **27%** were working greater depth

Writing – **71%** reached expected standard (National Average 74%) and **29%** were working at greater depth

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling – **100%** expected standard (National Average 72%) and **43%** were working at greater depth

Maths - **86%** expected standard (National Average 70%) and **43%** working at greater depth

### Progress from end of Key stage 1 to end of Key Stage 2

Average score as compared to all Year 6 children across the country is 0.
