

## Plan for Improvement and Development:

Our priorities for improvement and development for the coming year focus on three key areas;  
**Standards, Curriculum and Resources.**

Our recent National test results, most recent Ofsted and 2017 Parent and Pupil Questionnaire feedback have been used to decide upon the priorities for improvement:

### **Standards**

1. To increase the number of pupils achieving higher levels of attainment in Phonics at the end of Key Stage 1 to at least national expectation.
2. To increase the number of pupils achieving expected level of attainment in reading at the end of Key Stage 1 to at least national average.
3. Targeted reading, writing and maths intervention for a group in Year 3 to ensure they make expected progress.

### **Curriculum**

1. To increase the focus on teaching and learning of science in Quartz and Jet Class.
2. To further improve the communication of children's learning between school and parents/carers.

### **Resources**

1. Improve the learning environment for Reception children.
2. Review and improve site security

### 2017 National Test results:

**At the end of Year 2 in the National Tests** – 57% of pupils met the expected standard in Reading, writing and maths . We were just below the National Average which this year was 64%. The need to improve in this area will be met though the Improvement and Development Plan.

**At the end of Year 6 in the National Tests** - 60% of pupils met the expected standard in Reading, writing and maths . This was in line with the National Average which this year was 61%.
