What can we practise at home?

- **Read every day to an adult**
Children in Amber Class will have a home/school record book. We ask that parents write a comment in this book each time they listen to their child read. Teachers keep their own reading records at school but will sign the home/school record books to acknowledge your comments. Books will be changed on a regular basis by the class teacher.
- **Practise writing sentences**
Look for writing opportunities such as letters to family members or friends or a diary entry or report on a trip or weekend activity. Try to keep it fun!
- **Practise 2,3,5,10 times tables**
Learn these tables by chanting them. There are songs available on Youtube. Search for 'Percy Parker'
- **Add /Take away/Multiply/Divide**
Look for real life opportunities for maths problem solving, perhaps when laying the table or out shopping.
- **Measure**
Cooking is an ideal time to practise measure, weighing out ingredients.
- **Tell the time**
Look at the clock and practise on the hour and half past the hour, count round the clock in fives.
- **2D & 3D Shapes**
Look for shapes in the environment, can you name them? Which are 2D and which are 3D?
- **Work on your targets**
Each term your child is given personal targets on their report to work on.
