Attendance

It is vital that, when your child is well they make every school minute count. Please can you ensure that your child is in school and on time everyday.

They should arrive between 8.30 and 8.50 in the morning.

Government departments track school attendance figures. It is considered that attendance of 90% or below is **persistent absence** which will be closely monitored by school staff.

Langham Village School have a whole school attendance target which is 95%.

- If your child is unwell and you are unsure whether to send them to school, contact the office to seek advice.
- Avoid taking any holidays during term times.
- Keep up to date with what % attendance your child has so that you know if they are at risk of persistent absence, office staff can provide this for you and it will be reported to you at the end of the year.

- Speak to school staff with any concerns. Talk to your child about the importance of them being in school and let them know how important **you** feel it is.

You will receive the attendance letter from the local authority this week, this outlines the procedures for fixed penalty notices.

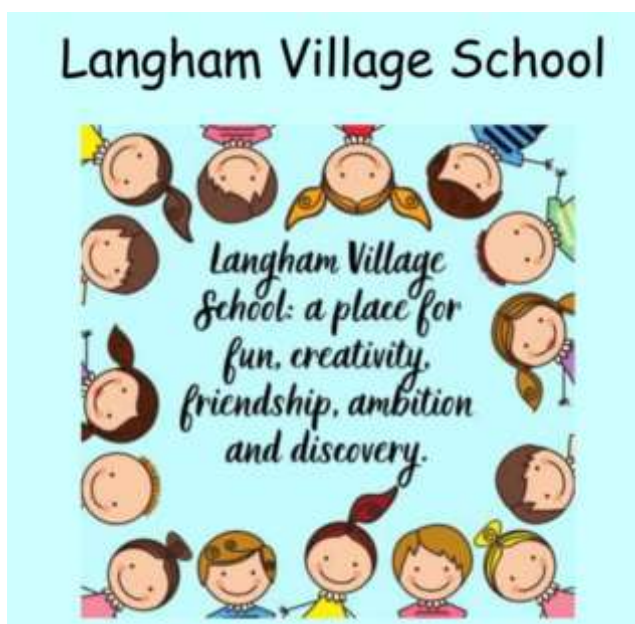
