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Parent Survey

Thank you to those of you who completed our Parent Survey in July. We had **38 responses (43% of the school)**

The results are as follows:

- 95% agreed that their child enjoys school.
- 95% agreed that their child feels safe at school.
- 97% agreed that they feel welcomed when they contact the school.
- 100% felt that the school has a happy atmosphere.
- 89% felt that the school helps to play an active role in school life.
- 97% felt that staff are accessible and approachable.
- 87% felt that they are given ways in which they can help their child's education.
- 92% knew how to contact a Governor.
- 95% felt that they are given sufficient information about the school's policies and plans.
- 97% felt that they are given information about social and fundraising events at school.
- 100% felt that they are given sufficient information about what their child is learning.
- 89% felt that the school has appropriate expectations of their child.
- 89% felt that they are kept well informed of their child's progress and achievements.
- 95% felt that the system of rewards is effective.
- 87% felt that the school deals with inappropriate behaviour effectively.
- 89% felt that their child is confident that there is an adult that they can talk to at school.
- 89% felt that the school is a place where everyone is valued.
